### **TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. Entry is open to all members of Florida State USBC Women's Bowling Association who are 55 years of age or older at the time of entries close, October 1, 2010.
2. Tournament will consist of Doubles and Singles events. Singles will be divided into two divisions; Div. 1 - 55 to 64 years of age and Div. 2 - 65 years of age and older. There will be only one division for the doubles event and doubles partners need not be in the same division or age bracket.
3. An entrant must bowl in both events (Doubles and Singles).
4. Entrants may compete only once in each event.
5. Handicap will be 100% of 200.
6. Entrants in the Florida State USBC WBA Seniors' Tournament shall use their highest USBC certified league average at the end of the 2009-10 season provided they have 21 games or more. If no 2009-10 winter USBC certified league average has been established, an entrant shall use her highest USBC certified 2010 summer league average for 21 games or more. If no 2009-10 winter or 2010 summer USBC certified average has been established, an entrant shall use their highest current USBC certified league average for 21 games or more as of Nov. 1. Entries which include bowlers who do not meet these average requirements shall automatically bowl scratch (210).  
THE ENTRANT MUST USE HER HIGHEST USBC CERTIFIED LEAGUE AVERAGE REGARDLESS OF WHETHER BOWLED AS A REGULAR OR SUBSTITUTE.
  - a. Where average records are published by the local association, the book average will be recognized as official providing:
    1. The average book lists the highest average of all USBC certified leagues, including mixed leagues, regardless of whether bowled as a regular or substitute.
    2. Averages are based on 21 games or more.
    3. The cut off date is March 1, 2010 or later.
7. USBC Rule 319a (1 & 2) and USBC Rule 319d and 319e do not apply. USBC Rule 319a-3 applies. All winner's averages are subject to further verification by the tournament secretary. Tournament management reserves the right to adjust handicaps upward or downward in the event verification reveals incorrectly submitted averages.
8. Closing date for entries will be October 1, 2010.
9. All prize money will be returned 100% at the ratio of at least one prize for each 10 entries.
10. Winners in each division are eligible to participate in the National USBC Seniors Championships - Women's Division. The combined total of 6 games plus handicap will determine the champions. In the event of a tie for first place in any division, and since only one is eligible to participate in the National USBC Seniors Championship Tournament, the tie will be broken by using the highest series with handicap. If a tie still exists, the tie will be broken by using the highest game with handicap.
11. All entrants are automatically eligible for all event awards if they bowl doubles and singles. To be eligible for the cash awards in the All Events an additional Two dollars (\$2.00) entry fee must accompany the entry form. Paid all events are not transferable unless the substitute replaces the original entrant in two events and the transfer is made by the tournament manager or her assistant prior to the time of the substitute participation in any event. All events includes handicap.
12. The tournament committee will rule on anything not covered by these rules or USBC tournament rules. All decisions of the tournament management are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
13. Pacers will not be permitted.
14. No food or beverages of any kind is allowed in the bowler's circle.
15. In the Doubles and Singles, individual members must check in personally not less than 30 minutes before they are scheduled to bowl. In case of substitutions, one hour before scheduled to bowl.
16. No changes will be made in the entrant's scheduled time except in case of emergency and any change must be approved by the Tournament Director or duly authorized Florida State USBC WBA official.
  - a. In annual tournaments, the order of bowling events will be decided by the Tournament Director.
17. The Florida State USBC WBA Senior Tournament, its officials and agents shall be liable only to the extent of return of entry fees if and when the entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting therefrom, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Florida Women's Senior Tournament.

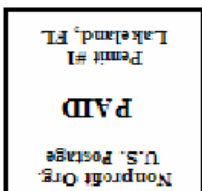
